

Narrative

Sir,

On July 12th, 2020 at approximately 1400 hrs., the listed victim, Jacqueline BOYD reported to this detective that the two listed suspects (YAHNER/DOUGLAS) in the course of a civil unrest/protest, blasted her ears with a megaphone causing extreme pain to her ears and verbally threatened her.

Ms. Boyd is employed at the TownHall, 1909 W. 25th Street, Cleveland. She was stationed in the back patio portion of the establishment admitting patrons with masks and checking ID's. Several protestors were protesting in the alley by where she was stationed and several were using megaphones.

Ms. Boyd advised that she will be seeking medical attention and that her hearing is currently severely damaged.

Both suspects positively ID'd. Additional suspects may be added at a later date.

INVESTIGATION:

On Sunday, July 12th, 2020 at 0900 hrs., I reported to the CDP Intelligence unit for roll call. After roll call, I was assigned to a scheduled ANTIFA/BLM protest at 1909 W. 25th Street, the TownHall restaurant and bar. I was dressed in plain clothes and working under the direct supervision of Sgt. Stephan Williams #9252, car 59.

CDP uniformed officers assigned to this protest were Sgt. John Mullin #9274, and P.O. Omar Troche #1878 in zone car 2S15, P.O. Migdelio Camargo #72 and P.O. Zachary Lowry #2539 in zone car 2A14, P.O. John Hategan #1879 and P.O. Michael Rasberry #2077 in zone car 2F16. All uniformed personnel were equipped with their mandatory City of Cleveland issued WCS's and working under the direct supervision of Capt. Robert Tucker #6574 (2S51), and Lt. Patrick Petranek #8525.

During the course of this scheduled protest, a female victim sustained a serious injury to her right ear caused by two of the protesters. Below are the circumstances and cause of that injury.

The ANTIFA/BLM protest started at 1212 hrs. The protesters, numbering around 8 to 10, were standing on W. 24th Place, directly behind the TownHall bar, 1909 W. 25th Street. The TownHall has a rear patio, which is fenced in with black aluminum fencing. There is a gate which opens onto W. 24th Place used as an entrance and exit to the patio. The 8 to 10 protesters were positioned approximately 13 feet directly across from this open gate.

Jacqueline BOYD (victim) is employed by the TownHall bar. She was working the 9am to 5pm shift on Sunday, July 12th, 2020. Ms. Boyd was stationed at the rear patio gate checking ID's and ensuring that everyone entering the bar through this entrance was wearing a face mask as mandated by Ohio state law.

At approximately 1300 hrs., I arrived and parked on W. 25th Street just north of the TownHall. As I sat in my vehicle, I began to hear an extremely loud siren coming from the rear of the bar and observed several patrons leaving the bar shaking their heads and holding their ears. As a matter of public safety, and to ascertain why people were leaving this bar in obvious distress, I left my car and entered the bar through the front door. I immediately heard a loud police like siren coming from the rear patio. I made my way to the back patio and sat in an empty booth.

In looking towards the rear of the patio, I observed several ANTIFA/BLM protesters staging their protest. A black male, Josiah A. DOUGLAS (OFFENDER #1), was immediately recognized and observed with a red and white megaphone slung across his chest. From approximately 1310 hrs., until 1324 hrs., I watched Douglas and other protesters exercising their First Amendment rights by using this megaphone to blast the police sounding siren and to amplify their voices to hurl insults and profanities towards the bar.

At approximately 1324 hrs., I heard this extremely loud siren coming from the north side of W. 24th Place. The siren kept getting louder and louder. Shortly after, I observed a white female, later ID'd as Sydney O. YAHNER (OFFENDER #2), holding a blue and white megaphone. Yahner was pointing her megaphone in the direction of the victim and patio activating the blaring siren, over and over again. At this point, I noticed the victim start to cover/hold her ears. Douglas quickly joined in with his megaphone and for approximately thirty minutes, both Yahner and Douglas blasted the victim and patio with these megaphone sirens seemingly nonstop. The noise was so incredibly loud, several patio patrons left the patio through the front bar holding their ears. I called Sgt. Williams and advised him of this situation. Sgt. Williams stated that he heard some chatter over the radio and that the Captain and Lieutenant were coordinating a de-escalation plan to resolve this situation.

At approximately 1354 hrs., the victim, left her post by the patio gate and walked towards the inside bar. She was holding her ears and visibly shaking. As she passed me, I asked her if she was OK? She replied, "I think I've lost the hearing in my ear because of that blowhorn." "I think I'm going to have to go the hospital." She was on the verge of tears. I identified myself as a police officer and quickly took down her information. The victim was identified as Jacqueline BOYD. Ms. Boyd then left the bar.

The protest ended at approximately 1412 hrs., with the protesters walking south on W. 24th Place. Sydney O. Yahner was stopped at W. 26th Street and Lorain Avenue by P.O. Hateman and P.O. Rasberry and positively ID'd. This encounter was captured on their respective WCS's.

I returned to the INTEL office, completed and submitted LERMS #2020-21 0273. I called Ms. Boyd. Ms. Boyd stated that she still couldn't hear out of her right ear and that she was going to see if it improved in a few days. She also stated that she's had a non-stop headache since she left the bar. It was later learned that Ms. Boyd went to the emergency room (Cleveland Clinic, Avon Hospital) that evening because the pain in her ear and head was unbearable. She was seen by Tiffany A. Carr, PA-C, given a prescription and advised to follow up with her primary care physician.

On Tuesday, July 14th, 2020 at 1300 hrs., Ms. Boyd was examined by Hassan Abbass, MD. A brief synopsis of that examination is attached below. The full medical record will be included in the file.

HPI

Patient is complaining of tinnitus and discomfort in her right ear after exposure to loud noise through 2 mega-horns that was used next to her ear. She also noticed a decrease in her hearing and dizziness. The dizziness has improved but she continues to complain of the tinnitus and the muffled hearing mostly on the right side. She has no otorrhea. She has no fevers or chills or nausea or vomiting. She has no previous history of loud noise exposure or tinnitus or hearing loss and no family history of hearing loss.

Assessment / Plan

Mild sensorineural hearing loss on the right side following noise trauma from 2 megahorns adjacent to her right ear

approximately 3 days ago. The patient was advised that her hearing loss may be permanent. At this point she was started on 7 day course of prednisone followed by a taper. She was also advised that the sound level emanating from megahorns at the inferior level can exceed 110 dB which can result in permanent ear damage within 2 minutes exposure. She will follow up in 3 weeks for a repeat hearing test. She was also offered an MRI of the brain and IACs with contrast to rule out a retrocochlear lesion such as acoustic neuroma. She prefers to follow this clinically at this point and if there is any deterioration of the hearing then an MRI will be obtained.

On Tuesday, July 28th, 2020 at 1400 hrs., Ms. Boyd had a follow up examination. She was seen by Jill Kramer, AUD and Hassan Abbass, MD. A brief synopsis of that examination is attached below. The full medical record will be included in the file.

HPI

Patient presents for follow-up for the right sudden sensorineural hearing loss following noise trauma. She continues to complain of hearing loss and tinnitus on the right side. She is also complaining of headache associated with the tinnitus.

Assessment / Plan

Asymmetric sensorineural hearing loss on the right side following recent noise trauma with no improvement after treatment with steroids. This is leading to the tinnitus. That that this may be triggering migraine headaches also. The patient was informed that her hearing loss is most likely permanent and is very unlikely to recover. She was offered the option of using a hearing aid on the right side. She was also advised to follow-up in 6 months for a repeat hearing test. MRI will be considered if the hearing deteriorates further. She was also advised to schedule an appointment with a neurologist for further evaluation of the headaches. The total time spent with the patient was 50 minutes of which at least 10 minutes was spent discussing the hearing loss and tinnitus mitigation techniques and headache.

INVESTIGATION (RECORDED EVIDENCE):

Josiah A. Douglas's Facebook, Sydney O. Yahner's Facebook, 911 calls, and all listed officers WCS footage were examined during the course of this investigation. The results of those examinations are listed below.

On Sunday, July 12th, 2020, Josiah Douglas aired a public live feed on Facebook while protesting at the TownHall. The public live feed footage was later downloaded as evidence in this investigation. This live feed showed Josiah Douglas and other protesters using Josiah Douglas' megaphone in the course of this protest. At location 28:44, Josiah Douglas stated "Sydney's on her way, she coming with a loud ass megaphone, thing is definitely way too loud for comfort." At location 30:44, an unknown male was heard laughing and stated "That's gonna get annoying."

No other footage relevant to the victim's injury observed.

WCS FOOTAGE (SGT. MULLEN):

Sgt. Mullin and P.O. Trouche were parked facing south on W. 24th Place, approximately 30 feet north of the protest. Both officer had their WCS's activated.

29:34:00 – MARKER: Officer makes comment on how loud megaphone is, even with the windows up.

01:12:18 – MARKER: YAHNER arrives on scene blaring megaphone.

01:14:08 – MARKER: YAHNER addresses officer in car with megaphone.

01:23:13 – MARKER: DOUGLAS holds his ears.

01:36:40 – MARKER: Victim approaches z/c holding her right ear, followed by YAHNER.

01:39:09 – MARKER: DOUGLAS/YAHNER blast victim with megaphones while she's on the phone with 911. (RECORDED ON 911)

01:39:37 – MARKER: Victim again approaches z/c holding right ear, YAHNER quickly catches up blaring her megaphone. DOUGLAS approaches victim blaring his megaphone. Victim attempts to file a police report.

01:41:07 – MARKER: Victim approaches z/c again. YAHNER & DOUGLAS approach victim blasting their megaphones. Victim advised officers that she has to go to the Doctors.

01:42:00 – MARKER: Victim calls 911 for the 2nd time. DOUGLAS' siren is audible in the 911 call. (RECORDED ON 911)

01:43:12 – MARKER: DOUGLAS screeches megaphone, holds/rubs ears.

WCS FOOTAGE (P.O. LOWRY):

P.O. Lowry and P.O. Camargo were parked facing north at the end of W. 24th Place. Both officer's had their WCS's activated.

02:01:46 – MARKER: Victim approaches z/c and states "It hurts so bad, it's literally just ringing."

911 CALLS:

At 1349 hrs., the victim called 911 and stated "I need to report an harassment and this woman keeps blowing a blowhorn in my ear outside of TownHall and my ear is like really hurting and she won't go away." "They've been blowing it in my one ear and I'm like starting to lose the ability to hear." "She's blowing it right in my ear." "I can't even hear out of my right ear right now." "She's blowing that stupid blowhorn, they've got like three of them." "She's the second person to do it." "My ear is fucking.., I can't even hear out of my right ear." "She's doing it in my face." "She's wearing a black shirt and a purple skirt." "I can't hear out of my right ear and she keeps doing it."

AUDIBLE SIREN HEARD THROUGHOUT 911 CALL

At 1353 hrs., the victim called 911 again and stated: "I can't hear out of my ear and I'm going to have to go to the hospital." "I'm losing hearing in my ear and they won't stop blowing this horn at me." "I can't hear out of my ear, they're doing it right in my face." I just asked somebody else to sit there, because I'm like making sure that people have masks on at the door, so I can't leave and they have this blowhorn right in my ear and my eardrums like blown and I can't hear anymore and they won't stop." "I've asked them to stop several times, I asked the cops, I have it on camera, they get in my face, they stand there and blow it, I can't hear now." "Now I got blood in my ear." "I've been trying to hold it, it hurts so bad." "And I can't hear out of my right ear now." "I wanna press assault charges." "I can't hear out of my ear right now." "You hear this?" "Cover your ears, cover your ears." "You hear this?" "They're doing it in my face."

AUDIBLE SIREN HEARD THROUGHOUT 911 CALL

At 1354 hrs., the victim leaves the bar.


In reviewing the officers WCS cameras, from 1324 hrs. to 1354 hrs. (30 minutes), Josiah A. Douglas and Sydney O. Yahner blasted the victim with their megaphone sirens approximately forty-eight (48) times. Each blast varied from 3 seconds to 25 seconds and were from measured distances of 1 to 10 feet from the victim.

During the course of this protest, the victim was approached by several protesters. The victim stated that each time she spoke to them, she begged and pleaded with them to stop blasting her with the bullhorn and told them that they were hurting her ears. Josiah Douglas and Sydney Yahner refused to stop and actually appeared to blast the megaphones sirens more frequent.

On August 7th, 2020, I conferred with City of Cleveland Chief Assistant Prosecutor Aqueelah A. Jordan. Prosecutor Jordan reviewed and signed the Felony-Review Forms on Josiah A. Douglas and Sydney O. Yahner.
